CRIME & SAFETY

- Thefts and break-ins are increasing on St Maarten
- Tourists are advised to lock their cars, doors and windows at all times, and to protect their valuables.
- You should take basic precautions everywhere on the island, including being aware of one's surroundings, avoiding walking alone after dark or in remote areas, and locking all valuables in a rental or hotel safe.
